Napa Valley Streamflow Watch

Citizen Scientists to the Rescue!

WHAT Citizen scientists of all ages will collect data about where and when salmonid streams in the Napa River go dry each year. We want to launch this new program in early 2020.

NEED \$15,000

Collecting this data over a multi-year period will address an urgent gap in our understanding of where fish are struggling most, and guide our efforts to help by enhancing streamflows.

WHAT FISH EXPERTS SAY

"Perennial streams are vital for salmon, otters, and other aquatic life. Accurately mapping and protecting these areas is among the most important conservation actions we can take in Napa." - Jonathan Koehler, RCD Fish Biologist
